

“ALINA” TWIN SET



yarn *NAVY*

MATERIALS
ADRIAFIL YARNS

JACKET

MATERIALS REQUIRED

A total of 410 g yarn **Navy** consisting of 350 g pink no. 51 and 20 g of bright green no. 45, blue no. 44 and orange no. 65. Knitting needles no. 6. Two-tipped cable needle. Crochet hook no. 4.50. 40 cm pink detachable zipper. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

AGE: 7/8 YEARS

PATTERN STITCHES

Knitted stitch

Purled stitch

Plait stitch (work over 8 stitches):

Rows 1 and 3: knitted stitch.

Row 2 and next even rows: purled stitch

Row 5: k 8 tog. leftwise (= stand off 5 sts on cable needle in front of work, k4, knit up the standing stitches).

Rows 7, 9, 11 and 13: knitted stitch.

Row 15: repeat row 5.

Rows 17, 19 and 21: knitted stitch.

Row 23: repeat from row 5.

Openwork stitch (follow the chart).

Double crochet

Crab stitch: work like a double crochet from left to right.

GAUGE

10x10 cm. with knitting needles no. 6 and different stitches = 11.5 sts. and 18 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: using knitting needles no. 6 and the pink yarn cast on 44 sts. and work: 18 sts. in openwork stitch, 8 sts in plait stitch, 18 sts. in openwork stitch. When work measures 20 cm. from beg. to shape the armholes bind off at ends, every 2 rows, 4 sts., 1 st. When work measures 19 cm. from beg. of sleeve holes, bind off the rem. stitches.

Right front: using knitting needles no. 6 and the pink yarn cast on 22 sts. and work: 7 sts. in openwork stitch, 8 sts in plait stitch, 6 sts. in openwork stitch. When work measures 20 cm. from beg. work the neckline on the left of work in the same way as back. When work measures 34 cm. from beg. to shape the neckline bind off on right of work, every 2 rows, 5 sts., 3 sts., 2 sts. When work measures 5 rows from beg. of the neckline, bind off the rem. stitches for the shoulder.

Left front: work to match the right front.

Right sleeve: using knitting needles no. 6 and the pink yarn cast on 24 sts. and work: 14 sts. in openwork stitch, 8 sts. in plait stitch, 2 sts in openwork stitch, at ends incr. 1 st. every 4 rows 6 times, 1 st. every 2 rows 4 times and work the new stitches in openwork stitch. When work measures 23 cm. from beg. to shape the armholes decr. at ends 1 st. every 2 rows 6 times. When work measures 7 cm. from beg. of sleeve holes, bind off the rem. stitches.

Left sleeve: work to match the right sleeve.

MAKE UP AND FINISH

With the crochet hook trim the bottom edges of the back and front in double crochet alternating 1 row with the bright green yarn, 1 row with the blue yarn, 1 row with the orange yarn, 1 row with the pink yarn. Then trim in the same way the bottom of the sleeves and the front buttoning sides, including the side of the bottom edge. Sew up the shoulders. Work a border as described previously around the neckline of the back and front (including the sides of the buttoning edges), but not including the last row in pink. Close and join the sleeves. Sew up the sides. trim all the edges of the back and front in crab stitch with the pink yarn. Sew on the zipper.

HAT

MATERIALS REQUIRED

A total of 80 g yarn **Navy** consisting of 20 g. in pink no. 51, bright green no. 45, orange n. 65 and blue no. 44. Crochet hook no. 4.50.

DIMENSIONS: the circumference of the hat is 46 cm.

PATTERN STITCHES

Chain stitch

Single crochet

Double crochet

Treble crochet

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

With the pink yarn cast on a 4 st. chain, closing with a 1 sc. loop and, in the loop obtained, work:

Row 1: (pink) 8 dcs.; end this row and all the successive rows with 1 sc. in the initial st..

Row 2: (pink) 2 dcs. in each stitch below.

Row 3: (pink) alternate 5 dcs. and 5 trs. increasing 4 sts. (20 sts.).

Row 4: (green) * 4 trs., 8 dcs. *, rep. from * to * increasing 4 sts. (24 sts.).

Row 5: (orange) * 6 dcs., 4 trs. *, rep. from * to * increasing 6 sts. (30 sts.).

Row 6: (blue) * 5 trs., 7 dcs. *, rep. from * to * increasing 6 sts. (36 sts.).

Row 7: (blue) * 7 dcs., 4 trs. *, rep. from * to * increasing 8 sts. (44 sts.).

Row 8: (green) * 5 trs., 5 dcs. *, rep. from * to * increasing 6 sts. (50 sts.).

Row 9: (pink) * 5 dcs., 5 trs. *, rep. from * to * (from this row do not work in any more increases).

Row 10: (orange) * 5 trs., 5 dcs. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 11: (blue) * 5 dcs., 5 trs. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 12: (green) * 4 trs., 4 dcs. *, rep. from * to * decreasing 2 sts. (48 sts.).

Row 13: (green) * 4 dcs., 4 trs. *, rep. from * to * decreasing 4 sts. (44 sts.).

Row 14: (pink) * 4 trs., 4 dcs. *, rep. from * to *.



Row 15: (blue) * 4 dcs., 4 trs. *, rep. from * to *.

Break off and bind the yarn.


MAKE UP AND FINISH

With the blue yarn work an 8 cm. chain, fold in half and sew on at the top of the hat.

Hat pattern




Chart for jacket
