Knit  Crochet  Design



## Crochet Heart Garland

### **Materials**

Use oddments of any DK yarn that has a knit tension of 22 sts and 28/30 rows over stocking stitch on 4mm (UK/Canada/Aus no.8, US no.6) needles.

### **Size**

Each heart measures approx 7.5 cm (3in) wide by 7.5 cm (3 in) tall.

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## **Tension/Gauge**

Tension is not critical but mine was as follows;

Using no 10 mm (N/15) hook, 6 dc and 4 rows = 10 cm (4 in) square.

Use larger or smaller hook if necessary to obtain correct tension.

## **Abbreviations (UK)**

**Ch**—chain

**Dc**—double crochet

**Ss**—slip stitch

**Rep**—repeat

**sc**—Single crochet

**Rem**—remaining

**Tr**—treble

**Beg**—beginning

To Make

Using no 4 mm hook and any DK yarn

Make a magic circle and into it work: *(see page 3 for how to work the magic circle)*

**1<sup>st</sup> round:** 3 ch, 12 dc, join with ss to 3<sup>rd</sup> of 3 ch.

**2<sup>nd</sup> round:** skip 2 dc, 7 tr in next dc, 1 tr in next dc, 2 dc in each of next 2 dc, (2 dc, 1 tr, 2 dc) into next dc, 2 dc into each of next 2 dc, 1 dc in next dc, 7tr into next dc, using contrast yarn, ss to ss at end of 1<sup>st</sup> round.

**3<sup>rd</sup> round:** with contrast yarn ss across 1<sup>st</sup> tr, 2 sc in each of next 6 tr, 1 sc in each of next 7 dc, 2 sc in next tr, 1 sc in each of next dc, 2 sc in each of next 6 tr, ss across next tr, ss to 1<sup>st</sup> ss, fasten off,

Sew in ends.

Make 9 hearts or number required,

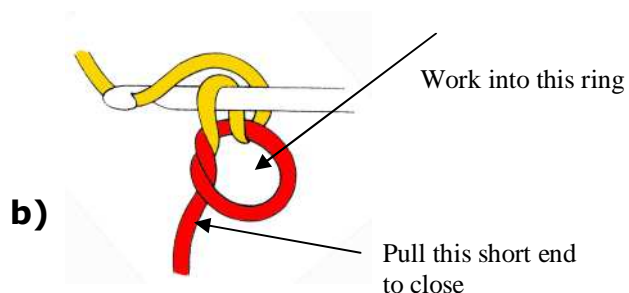
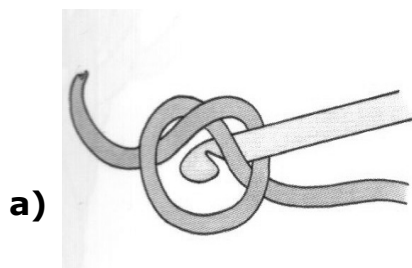
## **To Make into a Garland.**

With contrast yarn, and 4 mm hook, make a length of 15 ch, ss to top of 1<sup>st</sup> side of heart, 5 ch, ss to top of 2<sup>nd</sup> side of heart, 12 ch, rep from \* until all hearts are attached, finish last repeat with 15 ch. Fasten off.



## To Make a Magic circle

- 1) Begin to make a slip knot but do not pull up tight onto hook. (a)
- 2) Using the loop on the hook and working into the loose loop ring work as given in the pattern. (b)
- 3) Pull up the short end of the yarn to close the circle tight.



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
