Knit  Crochet  Design



Red Red Rose Crochet Brooch

Size

The rose measures approx 7 cm (3") across – not including the leaf.

Materials

25 meters from a 50g ball of DK (Light Worsted) knitting wool in Red

2.5 meters of green for the leaf

4 mm crochet hook (UK/Aus/Canada 8/ US 6)

Brooch back to make it into a brooch.

Wool sewing needle.

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The UK/Australia/Canada Version

Abbreviations

Ch—chain	Htr—half treble
Tr—treble	Dtr—double treble
Sp—space	Dc—double crochet
Ss—slip stitch	

The Rose

With 4 mm hook and red yarn make a length of 53 ch.

1st row: (1tr, 2ch, 1tr) worked into 6th ch from hook, (the first 5ch count as 1 tr, 2ch), * 2ch, miss next two foundation chain, (1tr, 2ch, 1tr) worked into next ch, repeat from * to end. (34 chain spaces)

2nd row: 3 ch, (counts as 1st tr), 4tr into 1st 2 ch sp, ss in next 2 ch sp, (5tr in next 2 ch sp, ss into next 2 ch sp) x 2, (6tr in next 2 ch sp, ss into next 2 ch sp) x 4, (8tr in next 2 ch sp, ss into next 2 ch sp) x 4, (12tr in next 2 ch sp, ss into next 2 ch sp) x 6.

Fasten off and leave a long end (about 50 cm) for sewing.

To Make Up

Starting at the beginning of the 2nd row, roll the work so that it forms a rose shape. Arrange as required then sew into place on the base. Sew a brooch back onto the back of the rose. Sew in all ends.

The Leaf

With 4 mm hook and green yarn make a length of 9 ch.

1st side of leaf: 1htr into 3rd ch from hook (1st 2 ch counts as 1st htr), 1 tr in each of next 2 ch, 1 dtr in next ch, 1 tr in next ch, 1 htr in next ch, work 3 dc into last ch, and turn work.

2nd side of leaf: working along other side of the same length of ch work as follows; 1 htr in next ch, 1 tr in next ch, 1 dtr in next ch, 1 tr in each of next 2 ch, 1 htr in each of last 2 ch.

Fasten off and leave a long end (about 30 cm) for sewing.

To Attach

Using the long end sew the leaf onto the back of the rose so that it just peeps out from behind the rose. Sew in all ends.

The US Version

Abbreviations

Ch—chain

Hdc—half double crochet

Ss—slip stitch

Tr—treble

Sc—single crochet

Sp—space

Dc—double crochet

The Rose

With 4 mm hook and red yarn make a length of 53 ch.

1st row: (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) worked into 6th ch from hook, (the first 5ch count as 1 dc, 2ch), * 2ch, miss next two foundation chain, (1dc, 2ch, 1dc) worked into next ch, repeat from * to end. (34 chain spaces)

2nd row: 3 ch, (counts as 1st dc), 4dc into 1st 2 ch sp, ss in next 2 ch sp, (5dc in next 2 ch sp, ss into next 2 ch sp) x 2, (6dc in next 2 ch sp, ss into next 2 ch sp) x 4, (8dc in next 2 ch sp, ss into next 2 ch sp) x 4, (12dc in next 2 ch sp, ss into next 2 ch sp) x 6.

Fasten off and leave a long end (about 50 cm) for sewing.

To Make Up

Starting at the beginning of the 2nd row, roll the work so that it forms a rose shape.

Arrange as required then sew into place on the base. Sew a brooch back onto the back of the rose. Sew in all ends.

The Leaf

With 4 mm hook and green yarn make a length of 9 ch.

1st side of leaf: 1hdc into 3rd ch from hook (1st 2 ch counts as 1st hdc), 1 dc in each of next 2 ch, 1 tr in next ch, 1 dc in next ch, 1 hdc in next ch, work 3 sc into last ch, and turn work.

2nd side of leaf: working along other side of the same length of ch work as follows; 1 hdc in next ch, 1 dc in next ch, 1 tr in next ch, 1 dc in each of next 2 ch, 1 hdc in each of last 2 ch.

Fasten off and leave a long end (about 30 cm) for sewing.

To Attach

Using the long end sew the leaf onto the back of the rose so that it just peeps out from behind the rose. Sew in all ends.
